### Description

statswales\_get\_dataset returns a dataframe from **StatsWales** using a dataset id.

**Usage**

```
statswales_get_dataset(id)
```

**Arguments**

id	A dataset id. Must be a single string.

**Value**

If the dataset id is valid, the function will return the requested dataset in a dataframe. If the id is not valid, the function will return NULL.

**Examples**

```
data <- statswales_get_dataset("LGFS0021")
```
